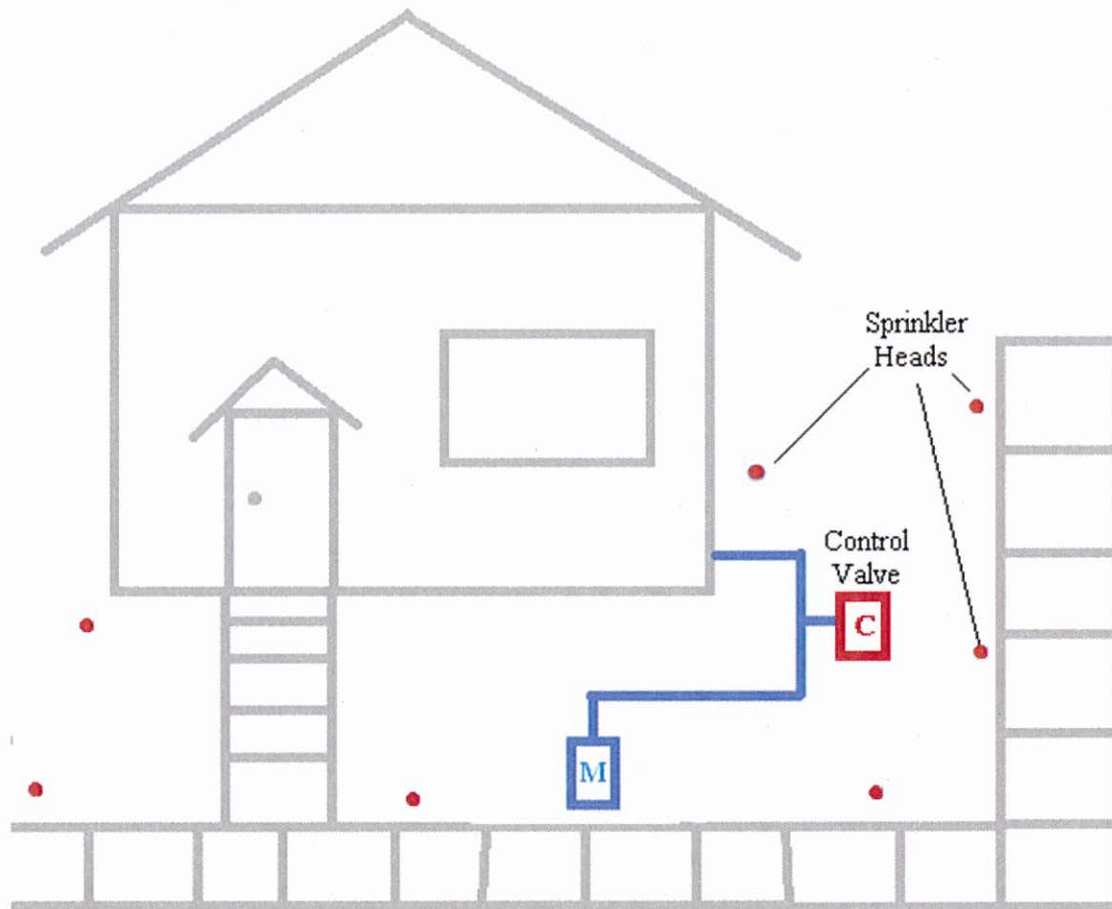


Irrigation Leaks



If your water usage is high but there is no movement on your meter you may have an irrigation leak. When the pipe breaks between the meter and the house the meter will constantly register water flow. Toilet leaks may show as intermittent leaking on the meter. If the mechanism in the back of the toilet doesn't seal properly it can allow water to seep into the bowl constantly. When the reservoir tank gets low enough it will refill. A common misconception is you will hear the problem.

A sprinkler system has its own control valve. If the water is off at the control valve there is no water going to the pipes that lead to the sprinkler heads all over the yard. When the system is on it then allows water to flow to the sprinkler heads. If one of the pipes is broke it could also be allowing a lot of extra water to escape below ground. Our crew cannot tell you if you have a leak in your irrigation system. If you suspect there is a problem and need assistance you will need to call a plumber or an irrigation specialist.
