- Sunday: 1 pm–6 pm.

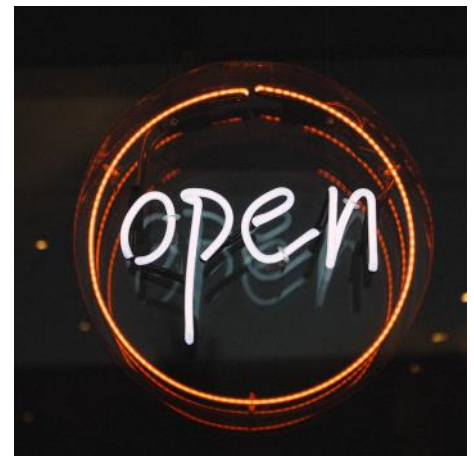
The building is open to the public for the following services:
