Summer Reading Program starts June 1



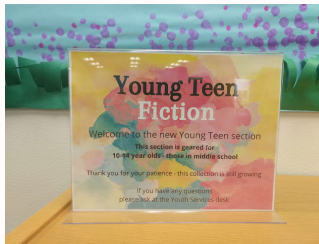

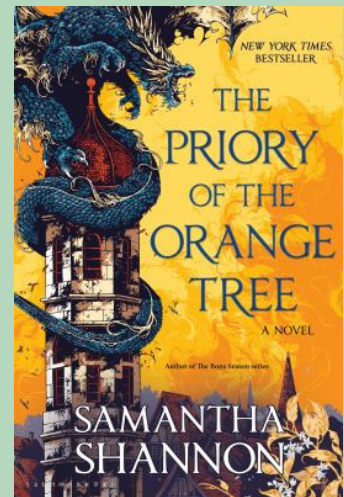
