In October, the Clackamas County Clerk's office installed a new ballot box at Wilsonville City Hall.

The new ballot box is located in the round driveway behind the building, next to the City Hall parking lot.

Enhancements to the ballot box include: more capacity, better visibility, improved accessibility, as well as increased security.

With the new outdoor location, the ballot box is



now available 24/7 and has drive-up access, which should make it more convenient to drop off your ballot.

Just a reminder: ballots must be dropped off by 8:00 pm on Tuesday, November 6.

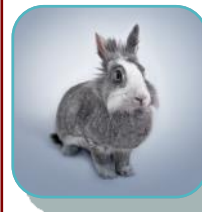
