

RESOLUTION NO. 153

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN APPLICATION FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
GRANT FROM PORT OF PORTLAND FOR DEVELOPMENT OF BOONES FERRY
PARK BOAT DOCK RECREATION AREA

WHEREAS, the City Council, at its regular meeting on June 2, 1980, received an unanimous recommendation from the City's Park Commission to seek a technical assistance grant from the Port of Portland to develop a Boones Ferry Park Boat Dock Recreation Area; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council found, at its June 2, 1980 meeting, that there was a public need to develop such a facility on the Willamette River featuring a complete non-motorized boat dock and enclosed swimming area with beach, to improve ramp for pedestrian and physically handicapped for access to river, and to improve river embankment for paved pedestrian trails along the river; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council, upon motion duly moved, seconded and unanimously approved the Parks Commission recommendation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville hereby endorses the application for a Port of Portland Assistance Grant for development of Boones Ferry Park Boat Dock Recreation Area; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Staff be instructed to submit such application to the Port of Portland and to fully cooperate with the Port of Portland in the implementation of the Technical Assistance grant.
