

RESOLUTION NO. CXCII (192)


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF NEW RECORDING EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Dee Thom, City Recorder, has presented to the Council on October 19, 1981, the fact that the present UHER recording machine needs to be replaced because it is malfunctioning in the recording system as well as the reels are not operating properly. Repairs have not been effective, and the cost effectiveness of future repairing attempts versus purchasing a new UHER recording machine is determined to be more cost effective through the purchase option; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the purchase price of a new recording machine is \$1,088.95 and said purchase could be funded through the contingency fund in the General Fund - Administration and implemented through a supplemental budget.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, that the City Council authorizes the City Recorder to purchase a new UHER recording machine in the amount of \$1,088.95 to be funded through contingency and General Fund - Administration and said funding to be implemented through a supplemental budget.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 16th day of November, 1981, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same date.
