Plastic bottles, plastic round containers, metal, paper, cardboard & cartons
6 oz or larger, empty & dry. No plastic lids. Flatten cardboard.

Food & Yard Waste

Only City of Wilsonville customers may include food waste.

Glass

Batteries

Pilas батарейки Bin 电池

1. Prepare
2. Bag all batteries
3. Set on top of glass bin

Tape

- Button cells
- Rechargeable
- Lithium/Li-ion
- Battery packs (laptop/cell phone)

Do NOT Tape

- Alkaline (AAA to D size)
- Carbon Zinc
- 6- & 9-volt

Single-family residential customers only.

Garbage

All garbage, including plastic bags, to-go cups and clamshell containers, lids & packaging, wires and extension cords

Prescription Medications

Drop off for free at:

Motor Oil: Put in a labeled, screw-top container and set next to your glass bin. Residential only.

Tips for Better Service:

- Place carts 2-3 feet apart and away from parked cars, hanging branches, etc.
- Villebois: carts must be placed at arterial roads, not in alleys
- Multifamily communities: do not block garbage enclosures

Wilsonville's Special Garbage Days:

- Bulky Waste Day (spring, fall)
- Leaf Collection (November)
- Paper Shredding (fall)

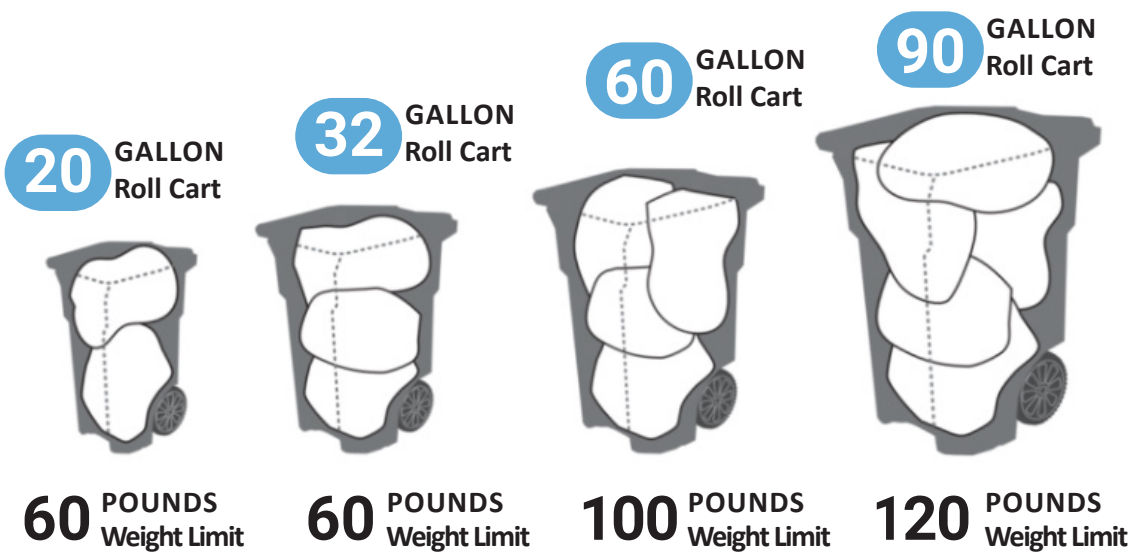

COLLECTION DAY REMINDERS

- Place containers within 3 feet of curb with 1-2 feet between them.
- Extra garbage? Set out an extra bag on your collection day for a small fee.
- Call Republic Services to pick up items too large to fit in your garbage cart, including large bulky items, for an extra fee.

BEYOND THE CURB

- Buying good-condition, secondhand items saves money and avoids waste.
- Many materials not accepted for curbside recycling can be recycled at drop-off sites.
- Toxic chemicals, light bulbs, computers, TVs, sharps, block polystyrene, and other hazardous waste must be taken to drop-off sites that properly handle them.
- See other side for drop-off sites that take special items; see below for new Recycle+ opt-in program for hard-to-recycle items.

CHOOSE YOUR SERVICE LEVEL

- WEEKLY Pick Up:** One garbage container, plus additional containers each for recycling, glass/batteries, and organics/yard waste*.
- MONTHLY Pick Up:** One, 32 gallon garbage container, plus one additional container each for recycling and glass. Garbage pick up is monthly; other collections are weekly.
- ON-CALL Pick Up:** One, 32 gallon garbage container. Call for pick up.
- *Yard waste in City of Wilsonville only.

Recycle+ Opt-in Program for Hard-to-Recycle Items

Conveniently recycle more items with this optional service available to residents of single-family homes through four-plexes. Republic Services is now testing to see how these programs can be implemented at multi-family community facilities.

Recycle+ is an on-call service with a monthly base fee and a pickup fee per collection at the curb; for an additional fee, customers may arrange pickup at an agreed upon location other than the curb.



Materials accepted in the Recycle+ collection service include:



- Stretchy plastic film/bags**
- Plastic bags - Produce bags - Dry cleaning bags
 - Plastic padded envelopes (no padded manila envelopes)
 - Plastic overwrap for paper towels, paper plates, napkins, etc.



- Clear plastic #1 clamshell containers**
- Egg cartons
 - Fruit containers
 - Bakery containers
 - Take-out containers



- Textiles**
- Bed linens
 - Clothing
 - Towels/rags



- Compact fluorescent light bulbs**
- Long fluorescent tubes used in commercial lighting are Not accepted
 - Bulbs must be contained in a zip-sealed bag

Customers opting-into Recycle+ receive a purple bin and bags prior to the first collection day. Contact Republic Services at least two business days before collection day to request pick up. Set the special bin at the curb by 6 a.m. on collection day. All bagged materials must fit inside the bin, with the lid on.

Customers with a lawful disability can request non-curbside pickup at no extra charge; contact Republic Services for more information.

The Recycle+ service includes special collections a few times each year of specific items for recycling or donation, such as silverware, kitchen utensils, cutting boards and more.

- Items NOT accepted by Recycle+:
- Knives
 - Dishes
 - Small appliances
 - Broken or rusty items
