ORDINANCE NO. 180

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT PURCHASE OF PETROLEUM TANKS, PUMPS, FITTINGS AND A SIX CUBIC FOOT CEMENT MIXER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City of Wilsonville's Public Works Director, Larry Blanchard, the City of Wilsonville called for bids pursuant to duly and regularly published advertising for petroleum tanks, pumps and fittings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville received one bid only which was opened at 2:00 p.m., on March 26, 1981, read aloud at the Wilsonville City Hall and the results of the bidding reported to the Mayor and Wilsonville City Council by Memorandum of March 31, 1981, of Public Works Director, Larry Blanchard, and said Memorandum reported that the one bid was from Mascot Equipment Company for \$5,464.50 with the further recommendation that it be accepted as the low bid; and

WHEREAS, bids were requested by the City with regard to a six cubic foot cement mixer, specifications for which were prepared by the City's Public Works Director and bids were received from three firms, the results of which were reported to the City Council by Memorandum of the Public Works Director of March 13, 1981, as follows:

The March 13, 1981, Memorandum went on to recommend that the low bid of \$1,259.00 for Hertz Equipment Rental be accepted, but since the total budget for this item was \$1,000.00, that the balance of \$259.00 be taken from the respective contingency funds for the Department funds which were making up the budgeted total of \$1,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City Council/Contract Review Board has considered the bids, the specifications on said equipment, and the reports and recommendations of its Public Works Director and determined that the low bid for the petroleum tanks, pumps and fittings is that of \$5,464.50 from Mascot Equipment Company and that the low bid for the six cubic foot cement mixer is that of Hertz Equipment Rental in the amount of \$1,259.00,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS, as follows:

Section 1: The bid of Mascot Equipment Company for petroleum tanks, pumps and fittings, in the amount of \$5,464.50 is hereby accepted in accordance with the specifications as prepared by the Public Works Director.

Section 2: The bid of Hertz Equipment Rental in the amount of \$1,259.00 for a six cubic foot cement mixer is hereby ac-

cepted in accordance with the specifications prepared by the City Public Works Director. The excess of \$259.00, over the budgeted figure of \$1,000.00, shall be transferred from the contingency fund for each department fund contributing to the budgeted figure on a pro rata basis.

Section 3: The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville on its behalf a contract with Mascot Equipment Company for the purchase of petroleum tanks, pumps and fittings according to the specifications therefor, and any changes or modifications of those specifications as may be approved by the City Council and which said specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

Section 4: The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville on its behalf a contract with Hertz Equipment Rental for a six cubic foot cement mixer according to the specifications therefor, and any changes of those specifications as may be approved by the City Council and which said specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

Section 5: Payment by the City of Wilsonville of the purchase contracts authorized in the above are to be made according to the schedule of payments as outlined in the contract purchase documents.

Section 6: In order that this equipment come on line to provide efficient, timely and cost effective services to the citizens of Wilsonville, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final reading and passage by the Wilsonville City Council.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 20th day of April, 1981, and scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 4th day of May, 1981, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., at the Wilsonville City Hall.
