ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PREVIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL COMMISSION'S ORDER NO. 4 AS A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville has determined that it is in the best interests of the welfare and public safety of its citizens to reorganize the Traffic Control Commission into the Traffic Safety Commission, and said commission will no longer be authorized to adopt orders governing traffic matters; and

WHEREAS, said reorganization therefore necessitates the adoption of previous adopted orders as ordinances; and

WHEREAS, those orders dealing with parking and traffic signing regulations for particularized geographic areas shall be adopted as special ordinances, and those orders dealing with comprehensive traffic regulations shall be adopted as general ordinances, and shall be codified;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wilsonville Ordains as follows:


1. It is hereby declared that Traffic Control Commission Order No. 4 shall be a special ordinance of the City of Wilsonville.
2. No vehicle shall be parked or left standing on the right-of-way of Parkway Avenue, which is also State Highway I-5 east frontage road, from Wilsonville Road south to the intersection of Holly Street and Parkway Avenue, save and except as is set forth in Section 3 below.

3. There shall be permitted during the hours of 7 P.M. to 7 A.M. parking of motor vehicles along the eastern right-of-way of Parkway Avenue beginning at a point 100 feet north of the center line of Holly Street and then north a distance of 450 feet, excepting egress and ingress and 5 feet on each side of such egress and ingress to the adjacent properties to the east of said right-of-way.


4. The City Administrator shall cause the appropriate change of signing to be duly erected, including notification and submittals, if any, to the Oregon State Highway Division.

5. It being determined by the Wilsonville City Council an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final reading and passage by the Wilsonville City Council.


