

ORDINANCE NO. 233

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF PARKWAY AVENUE ON BOTH EAST AND WEST PORTIONS OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM TOWN CENTER LOOP WEST TO BOECKMAN ROAD.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No semi-truck(s) and/or trailer(s) shall be parked or left standing on the right-of-way of Parkway Avenue on both the east and west portions of the right-of-way from Town Center Loop West to Boeckman Road.


Section 2. Any violations of this order will be administered under the provisions and penalties of Section 5 of the Wilsonville Code.

Section 3. The City Administrator shall cause the appropriate installation of signing as stipulated in the Uniform Traffic Code to be erected at the earliest time.

Section 4. It being determined by the Wilsonville City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final reading and passage by the Wilsonville City Council.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 2nd day of May, 1983 and


scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 16th day of May, 1983, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Willamette Valley Wesleyan Church.
