## ORDINANCE NO. 238

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.105(2)(d) OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE

WHEREAS, Section 2.105(s)(d) of the Wilsonville Code, as amended by Ordinance No. 227 provides that the City Administrator shall have authority to make expenditures not to exceed \$1,000.00 in any one transaction; and

WHEREAS, from time to time individuals, firms, or corporations purchase permits which require the purchase of water meters, valves, utility vaults, specialized equipment, or other items that exceed the expenditure authority of the Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary that the City Staff take appropriate and expeditious action where permits have been purchased.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wilsonville Ordains as follows:

 Section 2.105(2)(d) of the Wilsonville Code is amended as follows:
 (d) Be the Chief Purchasing and Business Agent with respect to

 all departments of the City and within budgetary limits and purposes,
 shall have authority to make expenditures not to exceed
 One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars in any one transaction.
 "In those circumstances where a permit has been purchased which
 necessitates the expenditure of funds for the purchase of materials
 or services to carry out the requirements of the permit, the above
 expenditure limitation shall not apply and the Administrator is
 authorized to make the expenditure necessary to meet the permit
 requirements."

 Ordinance No. 227, enacted by the City Council on February 22, 1983, is hereby repealed.
