I, the undersigned, City Recorder of the City of Wilsonville, State of Oregon, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say:



ORDINANCE NO. 268

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY TRAFFIC FLOW MODIFICATIONS FOR A SPECIFIC PERIOD OF TIME AS MENTIONED HEREIN ON COURTSIDE DRIVE STATION 0+00N TO 17+00N; AND STREET CLOSURE OF WIMBELDON CIRCLE NORTH STATION 1+00E TO 6+00E FOR THE GOOD CENTS SHOW OF HOMES.

WHEREAS, the City Council, at their regularly scheduled meeting, held in Wilsonville City Council Chambers, 30000, S. W. Town Center Loop East, at 7:30 o'clock p.m. Pacific Standard Time, on December 3, 1984, did review and approve a memo from Larry R. Blanchard, Public Works Director, titled "Good Cents Show of Homes/ Barron Construction - PGE"; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Commission, at their scheduled meeting, held in the Wilsonville City Council Chambers, 30000 S. W. Town Center Loop East, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. Pacific Standard Time, on January 10, 1985, did review agenda item TS 84-3 Good Cents Show of Homes, hereinafter referred to as SHOW, and made the following recommendations:

1. Wimbeldon Circle North Station 1+00E to 6+00E  
Street Closure.

- Closure plan and fence detail plan to be approved

by the Public Works Director

- Any damage to public facilities as result of the fence installation shall be paid for the SHOW's sponser.
  - No parking allowed on Wimbledon Circle North and South during the SHOW and all cul-de-sac's except for those who reside in dwellings addressed from Wimbledon Circle North or South, Wimbledon Court, Tournament Court, Courtside Way, Tennis Court, Grass Court, Raquet Court, Love Court, Champion Court. Barron Construction to provide residents with parking stickers to the residents, at no cost, so that their vehicles will not be towed.
  - Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District shall approve emergency vehicle access by written approval of the SHOW's access plan to the city.
2. Courside Drive Station 0+00N to 17+00N Parking Plan
- Public Works Director to approve plan prior to SHOW beginning.
3. Miscellaneous Requirements.
- Traffic signing for all traffic flow modifications and regulated parking areas shall be installed in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic

Control Devices, hereinafter referred to as the M.U.T.C.D., Section 2B and 2C. Any directional sign installations shall be in accordance with Section 2D of the M.U.T.C.D. Barricading and lane control shall be in accordance with Section 6A of M.U.T.C.D.

- Public Works Director shall have the authority to designate additional signing or Traffic Control personnel if it is determined that a traffic problem exists which could effect the health, safety or welfare of the public.
- Barron Construction shall provide deputized personnel for traffic control during the event. If it is determined by the Public Works Director that a traffic problem exists, Barron Construction will be required to provide additional signing and personnel to eliminate or reduce the affect of said problem.
- Barron Construction shall provide a certificate of insurance naming the City of Wilsonville as a third party insured, and complete a hold harmless agreement so that the city will not be held responsible for personal injury, property damage

and any other happening arising from incidents pertaining to this event.

- The streets mentioned herein shall be kept clean and free from debris on a daily basis. The Public Works Department shall notify Barron Construction of said nuisance and if Barron Construction has not caused said debris to be cleaned, the city shall then clean said debris. Barron Construction has two (2) hours from notice of nuisance to complete street cleaning. If the street cleaning has not been completed within that time period, the city will cause said cleanup of the street and all costs will be billed directly to Barron Construction.
- The date of this event will be a three week period in either April or May, 1985. Barron Construction will notify the city as soon as the final date has been determined.

WHEREAS, Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein, indicates those street sections under the traffic control designated in this ordinance.


THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Barron Construction shall be allowed to provide temporary traffic control and traffic flow changes


on Courtside Drive station 0+00N to 17 00N and Wimbledon Circle North station 1+00E to 6+00E as herein provided in paragraph 2, item 1, 2 and 3 for the Good Cents Show of Homes.

2. All costs of installations provided herein and for any future required installations shall be at the sole expense of Barron Construction.
3. Any changes to approved traffic flow modifications shall be approved by the Public Works Director prior to implementation and as set forth in the recommendations of the Traffic Safety Commission referenced above.



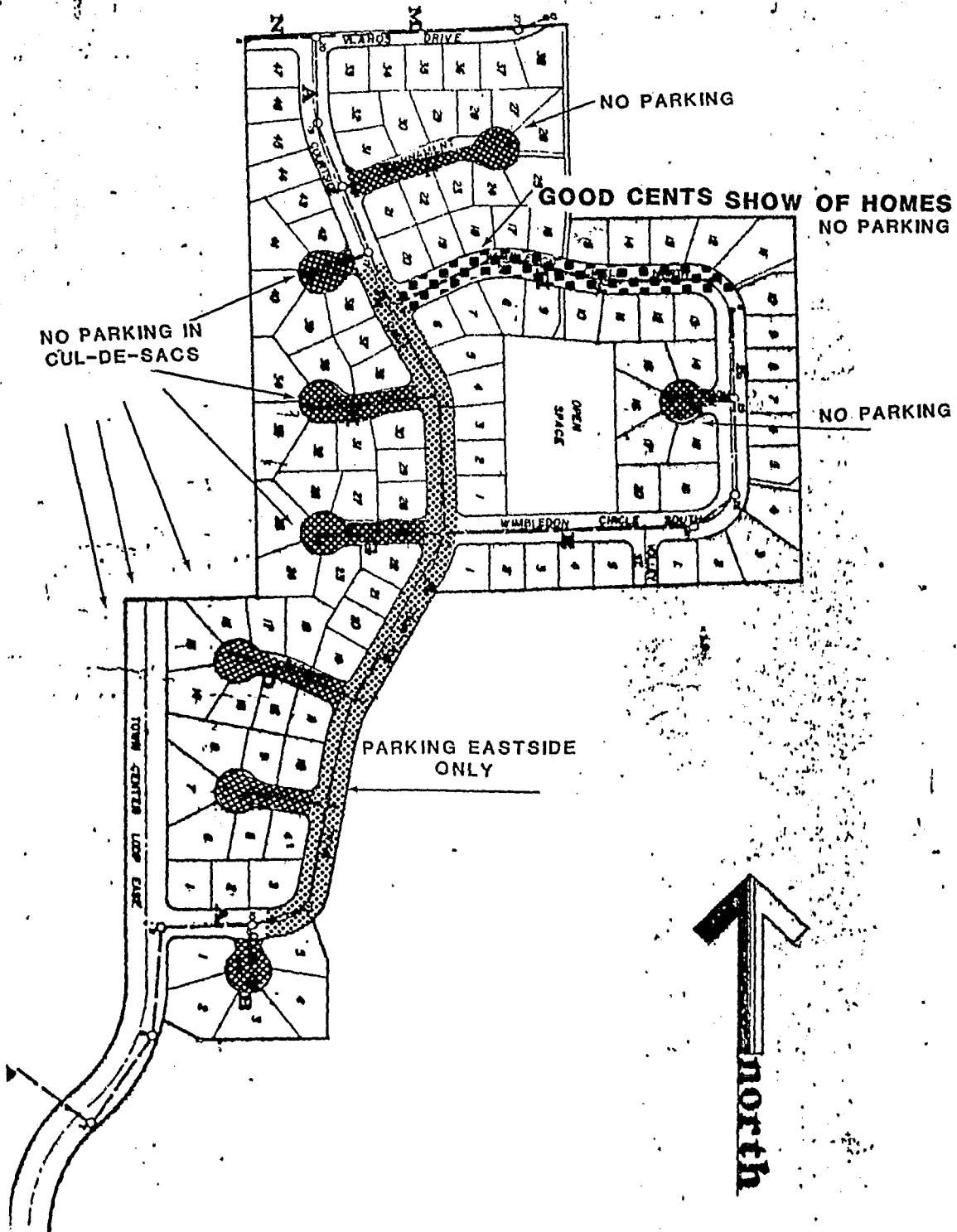
