

RESOLUTION NO. 1601

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CANVASS OF VOTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 20, 1999 SPECIAL ELECTION AND ADDING SECTION 43 TO THE WILSONVILLE CHARTER.

WHEREAS, at the Special Election held September 20, 1999, the electorate of the City of Wilsonville cast ballots for or against two ballot measures; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-58 asked the following question: "Shall the Wilsonville City Charter be amended to require voter approval for use of Willamette River as drinking water source?"; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-59 asked the following question: "Shall Wilsonville issue \$25 million in revenue bonds to treat and use the Willamette River as a long-term water source?"; and

WHEREAS, the election of the registered voters of Clackamas and Washington Counties was conducted by mail-in ballot through the U.S. Mail; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerks of Clackamas and Washington Counties, who by statute, are in charge of conducting all elections, have filed an abstract of the tally of votes cast at the election, which tally for Clackamas County was received on September 29, 1999, and for Washington County was received on September 29, 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Council of the City of Wilsonville does hereby adopt the votes of the September 20, 1999 Special Election as follows:

2. Based upon the adopted canvass of votes, the City Council affirms that
- a. Ballot Measure 3-58 has been approved by the electorate of the City of Wilsonville and the Wilsonville City Charter will be amended to add

“Section 43. The City of Wilsonville shall not use Willamette River water as a drinking water source for its citizens unless the question of so using the Willamette River water as a drinking water source has received the affirmative majority of the total number of legal votes cast on such measure and entitled to be counted thereon.”

b. Ballot Measure 3-59 has been approved by the electorate of the City of Wilsonville.

c. Ballot Measure 3-59 approves the question of using the Willamette River water as a drinking water source having received the affirmative majority of the total number of legal votes cast on such measure and entitled to be counted thereon.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Wilsonville at a regular meeting this 4th day of October 1999, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this date.
