RESOLUTION NO. 1087

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RATE INCREASE FOR UNITED DISPOSAL SERVICE, INC., TO ADJUST FOR COSTS OF NEW RECYCLING PROGRAMS MANDATED BY THE WILSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL AND MODIFYING SOME RATES FOR COMMERCIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMERS.

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council has mandated that the city's garbage franchisee provide yard debris recycling service to all residential garbage customers; and WHEREAS, the yard debris recycling program adopted by the Council is as follows:

Single family homes:

1,125

Container:

60 gallon roll cart

Frequency of pick-up:

weekly, year-round, same day as garbage

pick-up

Exemptions:

none

Golf Course Homes:

817 (413 excluded from program outright)

Container:

32 gallon roll cart

Frequency of pick-up:

Monthly, year-round, first garbage pick-upl

of each month

Exemptions:

none

Golf Course Homes participating in the program will be homes in the following homeowner associations: Charbonneau Homeowners, Fountain Lakes Homeowners, Fairway Estates Homeowners, Village Greens II, Oak Leaf Mobile Home Park.

Golf Course Homes excluded from the program will be homes in the following homeowner associations: Arbor Lakes, Charbonneau Greens, Lakeside, Village Greens I, Louvonne and Fairway Village; and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council has mandated that the city's garbage franchisee provide scrap paper recycling service to all residential garbage customers; and

WHEREAS, the scrap paper recycling program mandated by the Council requires that all residential garbage customers receive a recycling bin for scrap paper only and that scrap paper be picked up at the curb weekly on the same day as garbage; and

WHEREAS, the costs of these new programs require an increase in residential garbage fees; and

WHEREAS, "compactor trains" have become an increasingly popular and effective method of encouraging recycling in multi-family housing units and such recycling programs require that a fair and equitable rate be established; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the following rate schedule for weekly garbage and recycling service and found it to be fair and equitable:

I. RECYCLING SERVICES: THE RATES BELOW WERE ESTABLISHED TO INCLUDE THE COSTS FOR SPECIFIC RECYCLING SERVICES AS WELL AS THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE. THEY INCLUDE:

A. SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL:

- 1. WEEKLY CURBSIDE PICK UP OF RECYCLABLES ON THE SAME DAY AS GARBAGE SERVICE PROVIDING TWO 14 GALLON CONTAINERS.
- 2. WEEKLY CURBSIDE PICK UP OF YARD DEBRIS PROVIDING A 60 GALLON ROLL CART. ONLY YARD DEBRIS AT THE CURB IN THE 60 GALLON ROLL CART WILL BE COLLECTED.
- 3. "RECYCLING ONLY" AND "YARD DEBRIS ONLY" SERVICE AVAILABLE TO NON-GARBAGE CUSTOMERS AT A RATE THAT IS CONSIDERABLY LESS THAN IF THE CUSTOMER ALSO SUBSCRIBED TO GARBAGE SERVICE.

B. GOLF COURSE HOMES:

- 1. WEEKLY CURBSIDE PICK UP OF RECYCLABLES ON THE SAME DAY AS GARBAGE SERVICE PROVIDING TWO 14 GALLON CONTAINERS.
- 2. MONTHLY CURBSIDE PICK UP OF YARD DEBRIS ON THE FIRST GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY OF THE MONTH, PROVIDING A 32 GALLON ROLL CART, UNLESS THE HOME IS LOCATED IN A HOME-OWNER ASSOCIATION SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED FROM THE YARD DEBRIS RECYCLING PROGRAM BY CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 204.
- 3. "RECYCLING ONLY" AND "YARD DEBRIS ONLY" SERVICE AVAILABLE TO NON-GARBAGE CUSTOMERS AT A RATE THAT IS CONSIDERABLY LESS THAN IF THE CUSTOMER ALSO SUBSCRIBED TO GARBAGE SERVICE.

NOTES ON RESIDENTIAL SERVICE: (1) IN MOBILE HOME PARKS AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES WHERE THE OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT, THE CHARGE WILL BE \$22.55 PER 60 GALLON CART, \$17.65 PER 32 GALLON CART AND \$15.65 FOR A 20 GALLON CART. (2) CARTS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE FRANCHISEE TO REGULAR, WEEKLY CUSTOMERS WITH A CART SERVICE LEVEL ONLY. NO CARTS WILL BE PROVIDED ON AN ON-CALL BASIS. (3) 32 GALLON CANS CAN BE USED ONLY FOR THE OCCASIONAL EXTRA CAN FOR A REGULAR CUSTOMER OR THE OCCASIONAL CUSTOMER. (4) AN OCCASIONAL EXTRA 32 GALLON CAN FOR A REGULAR CUSTOMER SHALL BE \$3.00. (5) THE MINIMUM CHARGE FOR ANY STOP FOR AN OCCASIONAL CUSTOMER SHALL BE \$5.05 IF CASH AND \$6.55 IF BILLED. (6) A RATE SHALL BE CHARGED TO A "RECYCLING ONLY" CUSTOMER OF \$5.25 PER MONTH FOR WEEKLY COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIAL. IF THAT "RECYCLING ONLY" CUSTOMER ALSO WANTS YARD DEBRIS COLLECTION, THE MONTHLY RATE FOR WEEKLY COLLECTION SHALL BE \$9.25. (FOR A GOLF COURSE HOME, THE "RECYCLING ONLY" RATES WITH YARD DEBRIS COLLECTION SHALL BE \$7.25 PER MONTH FOR WEEKLY COLLECTION.) THE MONTHLY RATE FOR A "YARD DEBRIS ONLY" CUSTOMER SHALL BE \$5.00 FOR WEEKLY COLLECTION. EITHER A "RECYCLING ONLY" CUSTOMER OR "YARD DEBRIS ONLY" CUSTOMER SHALL SUBSCRIBE FOR SERVICE AND PAY A YEAR IN ADVANCE. (7) RECYCL-ING SERVICE (IN BINS) WILL BE PROVIDED TO AN OCCASIONAL CUSTOMER ONLY ON DAYS THAT GARBAGE IS COLLECTED FROM THAT CUSTOMER. MAY BE CHARGED FOR REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED OR LOST RECYCLING BINS OR TO CUSTOMERS THAT REQUEST MORE THAN TWO. (8) STATE ACCIDENT INSURANCE FUND (S.A.I.F.) SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL BE FOLLOWED. THE CAN SHALL NOT EXCEED 32 GALLONS AND 60 POUNDS. CANS TO BE OF RECOMMENDED TYPE AND LOCATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH S.A.I.F. RECOM-MENDATIONS. (9) YARD DEBRIS CARTS ARE INTENDED FOR THE COLLECTION OF YARD DEBRIS ONLY. IF THE YARD DEBRIS CART CONTAINS MATERIAL OTHER THAN YARD DEBRIS, COLLECTION SHALL BE CHARGED AT GARBAGE (10) CANS, CARTS, AND RECYCLING BINS SHALL BE AT CURBSIDE NO MORE THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO COLLECTION, AND SHALL BE REMOVED WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLES BY THE FRANCHISEE. (11) WHERE CUSTOMERS WITHIN A MOBILE HOME PARK OR APARTMENT COMPLEX HAVE INDIVIDUAL PICK-UP OF GARBAGE AND YARD DEBRIS FOR EACH UNIT, THE RESIDENTIAL RATE SHALL BE CHARGED. AN EXTRA CHARGE MAY BE MADE FOR SERVICE THAT INCURS ADDI-TIONAL DISPOSAL COSTS SUCH AS TIRES, MAJOR APPLIANCES, ETC., OR FOR HANDLING OVERSIZED, ODOROUS, DANGEROUS OR LIQUID ARTICLES.

NOTES ON COMMERCIAL SERVICE: (1) ADDITIONAL CARTS SHALL BE AT 100% OF THE FIRST CART RATE MULTIPLIED BY THE STOPS PER AN OCCASIONAL EXTRA 32 GALLON CAN FOR A REGULAR (2) CUSTOMER SHALL BE \$4.00 EACH OCCURRENCE. (3) AN EXTRA CHARGE MAY BE MADE FOR GARBAGE WHICH IS NOT READILY AVAILABLE ON COLLECTION DAY OR WHICH NEEDS ADDITIONAL JANITORIAL SERVICE. THE CHARGE FOR MULTIPLE UNITS OF ANY TYPE SHALL BE TO THE OWNER OF THE UNITS. (5) AN EXTRA CHARGE MAY BE MADE FOR SERVICE THAT INCURS ADDITIONAL DISPOSAL COSTS SUCH AS TIRES, MAJOR APPLIANCES, ETC., OR FOR HANDLING OVERSIZED, ODOROUS, DANGEROUS OR LIQUID ARTICLES. (6) WHEN A STOP USES THE EQUIVALENT OF 7 OR MORE 32 GALLON CARTS, THE COLLECTOR MAY REQUIRE THAT THE SERVICE BE SHIFTED TO A CONTAINER-TYPE SERVICE. (7) FRANCHISEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE CARTS TO ANY CUSTOMER WHERE THE USE IS NOT COMPATIBLE WITH THE CART. ALL CARTS WILL BE PROVIDED BY FRANCHISEE ONLY TO REGULAR, WEEKLY CUSTOMERS. NO CARTS WILL BE PROVIDED ON AN ON-CALL (9) THE WEIGHT OF THE 32 GALLON CART AND CONTENTS BASIS. SHALL NOT EXCEED 60 POUNDS. THE WEIGHT OF THE 60 OR 90 GALLON CART AND CONTENTS SHALL NOT EXCEED 180 POUNDS. (10) CARTS WILL BE PICKED UP AT CURBSIDE ONLY AND MUST BE THERE PRIOR TO THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED TIME OF COLLECTION. (11) CARTS SHALL BE AT CURBSIDE NO MORE THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO COLLECTION, AND SHALL BE REMOVED WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE BY THE FRANCHISEE. (12) WHERE CUSTOMERS WITHIN A MOBILE HOME PARK OR APARTMENT COMPLEX HAVE INDIVIDUAL PICK-UP OF GARBAGE, BUT NO YARD DEBRIS COLLECTION FOR EACH UNIT, THE COMMERCIAL RATE SHALL BE CHARGED.

B. COMPACTED:

FOR COMPACTED MATERIAL WHERE THE COMPACTED CONTAINER CAN BE DUMPED INTO THE COLLECTION TRUCK, THE CHARGE WILL BE TRIPLE THE ABOVE LOOSE RATE, AND THE COMPACTOR SHALL BE FURNISHED BY CUSTOMER AND SHALL BE COMPATIBLE WITH THE EQUIPMENT OF THE COLLECTOR. IT MUST BE MAINTAINED BY CUSTOMER IN A SAFE AND OPERABLE CONDITION (IN ACCORDANCE WITH WORKERS COMPENSATION BOARD REGULATIONS).

C. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS FOR CONTAINERS:

THE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF THE CONTAINER IS INCLUDED IN THE PRICE OF SERVICE. THE MINIMUM CHARGE FOR A CONTAINER SHALL BE THE ONE STOP PER WEEK RATE. WHILE NO RENTAL CHARGE WILL BE MADE ON CONTAINERS, WHERE CONTAINERS ARE USED IN HANDLING MATERIAL THAT CAUSES EXCESSIVE WEAR OR DAMAGE OR WHEN OTHER USAGE OR VANDALISM CAUSES DAMAGE TO THE CONTAINER WHILE IT IS LOCATED ON CUSTOMER'S PROPERTY, AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE MAY BE MADE FOR SUCH WEAR OR DAMAGE. THE CHARGE FOR DELIVERY OF A CONTAINER TO AN OCCASIONAL CUSTOMER SHALL BE \$13.75. THE CHARGE FOR EMPTYING SAID OCCASIONAL CONTAINER SHALL BE BASED ON THE FIRST STOP PER WEEK RATE.

V. DROP BOX RATES:

DROP BOX RATES SHALL BE THE FOLLOWING RATES PLUS 103% OF DISPOSAL FEES. THE DISPOSAL FEE INCLUDES ALL FEES CHARGED BY THE DISPOSAL FACILITY. THE RATES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

FOR COMPACTED MATERIALS THE CHARGE SHALL BE \$5.90 PER YARD PLUS COST OF DISPOSAL WHERE THE CUSTOMER FURNISHES THE COMPACTOR DROP BOX. HOWEVER, FOR A 15 YARD OR SMALLER COMPACTED DROP BOX, A COMPACTOR OF ANY KIND THAT HAS TO BE HAULED TO THE LANDFILL AND RETURNED TO THE CUSTOMER, THE SERVICE FEE SHALL BE \$72.95 PLUS 103% OF DISPOSAL FEES. IF THE COLLECTOR AGREES TO FURNISH THE COMPACTOR, THE RENTAL SHALL BE THE CURRENT RATE THE COLLECTOR WOULD PAY ON A LEASE-PURCHASE. BEFORE ACQUIRING A COMPACTOR, THE CUSTOMER MUST MAKE CERTAIN THE COMPACTOR TO BE ACQUIRED IS COMPATIBLE WITH THE EQUIPMENT OF THE COLLECTOR OR THE EQUIPMENT THE COLLECTOR IS WILLING AND ABLE TO ACQUIRE (AND MUST COMPLY WITH WORKERS COMPENSATION BOARD REGULATIONS.)

COMPACTED DROP BOXES UNDER 18 CUBIC YARDS SHALL BE \$82.79 PLUS 103% OF DISPOSAL FEE.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

- A. DELIVERY FEE FOR A DROP BOX SHALL BE \$15.00. A \$10.00 FEE PER HAUL SHALL BE CHARGED FOR DROP BOXES THAT ARE SCREENED. THE COST OF DISPOSAL AND FRANCHISE FEE ON DISPOSAL SHALL BE CHARGED IN ADDITION TO THE YARDAGE AND RENTAL CHARGES.
- B. MILEAGE CHARGES SHALL BE \$1.55 PER MILE FOR OVER 30 MILES ROUND TRIP TO THE DISPOSAL SITE (BASED ON THE POINT OF PICKUP TO THE POINT OF DISPOSAL) AND FOR OVER 18 MILES OF TRUCK OPERATION FROM WHERE THE TRUCK IS STATIONED FOR THE OCCASIONAL CUSTOMER OR THE REPEAT CUSTOMER REQUIRING SERVICE AT DIFFERENT TIMES.
- C. THE RENTAL RATE FOR A DROP BOX FOR LOOSE MATERIAL SHALL BE \$5.00 PER DAY AFTER 48 HOURS ON SITE OR \$50.70 PER MONTH, WHICHEVER IS LESS, IF LESS THAN ONE LOAD PER WEEK IS HAULED. FOR BOXES LEFT ON AN OCCASIONAL BASIS, THERE SHALL BE A RENTAL CHARGE OF \$5.45 PER DAY AFTER 48 HOURS ON SITE.
- D. DROP BOX RELOCATION FEE SHALL BE THE HOURLY HAULING RATE.

VI. MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE PROVISIONS:

A. HOURLY HAULING RATES (PLUS COST OF DISPOSAL):

- B. EACH LOCATON OF CANS, CARTS, CONTAINERS, OR DROP BOXES WILL BE BILLED AS A SEPARATE ACCOUNT UNDER THIS SCHEDULE.
- C. WHEN MATERIALS OR CUSTOMER ABUSE, FIRE OR VANDALISM CAUSES EXCESSIVE WEAR OR DAMAGE TO A CART, CONTAINER, OR DROP BOX, THE COST OF REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT MAY BE CHARGED TO THE CUSTOMER. CUSTOMERS SHALL TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO ENSURE THAT HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, CHEMICALS, PAINT, CORROSIVE MATERIALS, INFECTIOUS WASTE OR HOT ASHES ARE NOT PUT INTO A CAN, CART, CONTAINER OR DROP BOX.
- D. THE WEIGHT OF MATERIAL PUT INTO A CONTAINER OR DROP BOX, WHETHER COMPACTED OR UNCOMPACTED, SHALL NOT EXCEED THE LIFTING CAPACITY OF THE COLLECTOR'S EQUIPMENT NOR SHALL THE WEIGHT PUT THE COLLECTOR OVER THE WEIGHT LIMIT FOR THE LOADED VEHICLE. THE COLLECTOR SHALL FURNISH THE CUSTOMER WITH INFORMATION CONCERNING LIMITATIONS ON HIS EQUIPMENT, UPON REQUEST. IF THE WEIGHT OF A CONTAINER EXCEEDS 250 POUNDS (LOOSE), AN ADDITIONAL REASONABLE DISPOSAL FEE AND FRANCHISE FEE ON DISPOSAL MAY BE CHARGED. CUSTOMERS SHALL NOT OVERFILL A CAN, CART OR CONTAINER SO THAT THE LID CANNOT BE SECURELY CLOSED. IF A CAN, CART OR CONTAINER IS OVERFILLED AN ADDITIONAL REASONABLE FEE MAY BE CHARGED. IF THE CONTENTS OF A CONTAINER, CART OR DROP BOX ARE COMPACTED (EITHER MECHANICALLY OR MANUALLY), THE COMPACTOR RATE SHALL BE CHARGED.

- CUSTOMERS SHALL PROVIDE A SPACE FOR ALL CANS, CARTS, CONTAINERS OR DROP BOXES, WHETHER USED FOR GARBAGE OR RECYCLING, THAT HAS ADEQUATE AND SAFE ACCESS FOR COLLECTION PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT. THE SPACE PROVIDED MUST ALSO COMPLY WITH THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE DEVELOPMENT CODE.
- IF OVERTIME OR WEEKEND COLLECTION IS REQUIRED TO MEET THE REQUEST OF A CUSTOMER, THE HAULING PORTION OF THE RATE SHALL BE INCREASED BY 50%.
- TIRE COLLECTION RATES FOR 18" AND UNDER RIM SIZE SHALL BE \$1.50 PER TIRE IF OFF THE RIM AND \$3.50 PER TIRE IF ON THE RIM. IF OVER 18" RIM SIZE, SPECIAL HANDLING CHARGES SHALL APPLY.
- IF MATERIALS ARE DIVERTED TO A DIVERSION FACILITY, THE DISPOSAL FEE SAVINGS WILL BE PASSED ON TO THE CUSTOMER, BUT THE HOURLY HAULING RATE SHALL BE CHARGED IN ADDITION TO THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL FEE BECAUSE OF THE EXTRA DISTANCE TO THE DIVERSION FACILITY. (IN MANY INSTANCES THERE WILL STILL BE A SAVINGS TO THE CUSTOMER).
- EVERY PERSON WHO GENERATES OR PRODUCES SOLID WASTE SHALL HAVE ALL PUTRESCIBLE WASTES REMOVED AT LEAST EVERY 7 DAYS, WITH MORE FREQUENT REMOVAL IF NECESSARY TO PREVENT HEALTH HAZARDS, NUISANCES OR POLLUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH OAR 340-61-070(3).
