RESCLUTION NO. XV

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE SECOND ANNEXATION AND BOUNDARY CHANGE FOR THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE.

(Application of Ho Mil Oil Corporation)

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Wilsonville, Clackamas and Washington Counties, State of Oregon, to answer parts of Section 2, Termship 3 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Washington, State of Oregon, as hereinafter more particularly described and all of which lies wholly within the same County, i.e., Washington County, and is contiguous to the City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed consists of a business building site and an appertunent easement with a total land area of approximately one and one-half acres and pertinent information relative to each pareal and the emerships thereof are as follows:

- 1. A "PROPERTY EXETCH" prepared by Pettijohn Engineering Co., Inc. of Portland, Oregon, is attached hereto marked "EXHIBIT 1" for identification purposes and by this reference thereto and its association hereto is supressly made a part hereof, and said Exhibit identifies the areas proposed for annountion and their relationship to each other and to the existing boundaries of the Wilsonville city limits.
- 2. Parcel I of the proposed annexation consists of 0.913 acres which is exact in fee simple by Nobil Oil Corporation, a New York corporation, and proof of its ownership is shown in the duplicate Title Insurance Policy issued by Transamerica Title Insurance Co. issued September 25, 1970, under its Order No. 379759 which is attached herete and marked "EXMISIT 2" for identification purposes and by this reference thereto and its annexation hereto is expressly made a part hereof.
- 3. Parcel 2/2s on essence for sign and access purposes which consists of three contiguous percels identified in attached EXHIBIT 1 as Parcels A. B and C. which are 15 feet in width and

have a total length of approximately 336 feet. Said parcel is owned in fee simple by Faul E. Dety and Vada G. Lewis as temants in common as evidenced by the LOT BOOK SEARCH of Transamerica Title Insurance Co. deted October 5, 1970, under their Order No. 47-878 which is strached hereto marked "EXHIBIT 3" and by this reference therete and its annexation hereto is expressly made a part hereof. The miners of said coarcing granted the essement to Mebil Oil Corporation by an instrument dated September 9, 1970, which was recorded September 25, 1970, in Washington County Deed Records Book 793, Page 443. A copy of said "GRANT OF FASENERES" is attached herete marked "EXMIBIT 4" for identification purposes and by this reference thereto and its annexation hereto is hereby expressly made a part hereof. By the express terms of said Grant of Essements, the ensers of said property and the grantors of the easements expressly inderstood and agreed that the Mobil-Gil Corporation as grantee proposes to annex the real property described in said easements to the City of Wilsonwille, Oregon, and they expressly consented to the proposed amexation and agreed to "sign all required documents to amex Parcels A, B and C jointly with the annexation of the above referred to real property."

4. The presimity of the above referred to and hereinafter described parcels to the City of Wilsonville is shown on the City of Wilsonville map which is attached hereto marked "EXHIBIT 5" for identification purposes and by its annexation hereto and this reference thereto is throby expressly made a part hereof. The presimity of the proposed amenation to the City of Wilsonville is further shown in an air photo of the City of Wilsonville which is identified as "EXHIBIT 5" which is attached hereto and by this reference thereto and its summeration hereto is hereby expressly made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council and the Wilsonville City Planning Considered have considered the request of Mebil Oil

Corporation for assession to the City of Wilsonville and have investigated the matter and are of the opinion that it would be in the best interests of the City of Wilsonville and the inhabitants thereof if the said tegritery were assessed to the City of Wilsonville, and for the purpose of increasing the City's tax base, providing sever, water and other midities and other City services to the territory in quinties and also for the purpose of assuring a proper and orderly development of said property.

HOW, THEREFORM, HE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CERCKANAS AND HASHINGTON COUNTIES, OREGON, that it request and does hereby request the local government boundary conclusion formed under O.R.S. 199,410 to 199.540 to commonce necessary precedings for amounty to the City of Wilsonville the following described real property located in the County of Hashington, State of Oregon, hereits

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said City has jurisdiction to somewall property, and in the reliance on the suplication of Mobil Cil Corporation and the express consents of all owners of all the property proposed for expectation, is proceeding under the provisions and extensity of C.R.S. 222.170.

Of this Resolution with all attached Exhibits with the Boundary Commission having judgication in this matter; and if it takes no action in this matter within sixty (60) days from the date this Resolution is filed with the said Commission, that the City of Vilsonville shall consider that the Boundary Commission has consented to said annexation, and the City of Vilsonville will then proceed to annex said property pursuant to the laws of Opegon.

This Resolution is unanimously adopted by the Milsonville City Council and filed with the City Recorder this 26th day of October, 1970.
