

RESOLUTION NO. 209

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID(S) FOR USED EQUIPMENT OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Wilsonville Resolution (199) A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVERTISING FOR BIDS OF USED EQUIPMENT OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, adopted December 7, 1981, bids were advertised and received. The bids were duly opened on November 24, 1981, at 2:00 pm City Hall, City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS the Director of Public Works has recommended to the City Council by a memorandum, BIDS FOR CITY OWNED EQUIPMENT NOT IN USE, dated December 1, 1981, that:

Accept the high bid of Two Thousand Five Hundred One Dollar & no/100 (\$2,501.00) from Krypton Minerals Industries for the 35,000 gallon Water Tank; rejects all bids on the Sludge Truck and there being no bids received on the 1957 International Van directs staff to determine feasibility of alternative sale methods.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville upon due consideration hereby approves and accepts the high bid of Two Thousand Five Hundred One Dollar & no/100 (\$2,501.00) from Krypton Minerals Industries for the 35,000 gallon Water Tank.
