

RESOLUTION NO. 224

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE GOVERNOR'S
ECONOMIC RECOVERY PLAN AND DECLARING THE
CITY OF WILSONVILLE OPEN FOR BUSINESS

WHEREAS, the Governor of Oregon has initiated an Economic Recovery Plan to enhance the State's business climate by declaring the State "Open for Business", and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature has adopted said Plan and under the provisions of SB983 has made a Declaration that an economic downturn exists and that said downturn is of statewide concern, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has further found a public need to enhance job-producing enterprises in Oregon and has directed all public bodies to take the problem into consideration in the exercise of their powers, and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville Comprehensive Plan includes policies to insure overall stability through coordination with the County economic development plans and further to support a cooperative and active working relationship with the business community through the Chamber of Commerce, and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council finds it to be in the public interest to support the State's economic recovery plan and to promote organized, well-planned economic development within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council declares that the City of Wilsonville is "Open for Business",

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City shall support and promote the organization and coordination of economic development planning activities within the City with Washington County, Clackamas County and the Wilsonville Chamber of Commerce.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City shall support and promote orderly economic growth within the City consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan and Growth Management policies.

Adopted by the City Council at a regular meeting thereof on the 19th day of April, 1982, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same day.
