

RESOLUTION NO. 231

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF SPEED SIGNS, STREET NAME SIGNS, STOP SIGNS, WARNING SIGNS, DIRECTIONAL SIGNS, CONSTRUCTION HAZARD SIGNS FROM CLACKAMAS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of properly posting City Streets for notification to the public of the speeds, names, directions, warnings, and hazards on streets in the City of Wilsonville and;

WHEREAS, Clackamas County - Department of Environmental Services has a sign shop for making signs which the City of Wilsonville can purchase the necessary signs as required by the Uniform Traffic Code for the State of Oregon to install on City streets and;

WHEREAS, in most cases the City would be able to pick up most signs on the same day as requested from Clackamas County rather than the normal 4-5 week waiting period with private organizations and;

WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled Council Meeting on February 16, 1982, at 7:30 pm in City Hall a memo dated February 10, 1982, from Larry Blanchard - Public Works Director and entitled "PURCHASE OF STREET SIGNS" included the following recommendations:

- 1) Approve the purchase of street signs from Clackamas County Shop for a cost of \$1,521.25.

The memo also indicated the type of sign and the quantity and is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the City of Wilsonville shall approve the purchase of the 90 signs as referred to in Exhibit "A"

for a total cost of \$1,521.25 from Clackamas County - Department of Environmental Services.

ADOPTED by the City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 7th day of June 1982, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same date.

SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF STREET SIGNS

The Road Fund allocated approximately \$5,000.00 for the installation of speed signs, caution signs, stop signs, warning signs, direction signs, street name signs, and construction hazard signs. To date only a few signs have been ordered, primarily for replacement of signs either stolen or damaged.

In many cases the sheriff department would need some signing to enable them to write citations.

The number of signs necessary for purchasing are 90, which are designated as follows:

1.	30 - Speed signs @ \$15.00 each	\$ 450.00
2.	30 - Street signs @ \$15.00 each	450.00
3.	10 - Stop signs @ \$19.85 each	198.50
4.	10 - Warning signs @ \$19.85 each	198.50
5.	5 - Directional signs @ 25.00 each	125.00
6.	<u>5</u> - Construction hazard signs @ 19.85	<u>99.25</u>
Total	90	\$1521.25

The City presently purchases all traffic signs from Pacific Safety, however, at this time the City would like to purchase the majority of our signs from the Clackamas County Sign Shop. Clackamas County makes their own signs, and the City can purchase many of the standard signs from the county. Listed below are some of the advantages of purchasing signs from the County.

SIGN PURCHASES - COUNTY	SIGN PURCHASES - OTHER SOURCES
1. Delivery on Standard Stock signs are in general on a same day as ordered basis.	1. All signs ordered take usually 4 to 6 weeks.
2. The cost for all signs are generally less, even on special orders.	2. Cost range from \$20.00 to \$108.00 per sign depending on size.
3. The City can work with the County to budget enough in stock material to supply our sign needs annually.	3. Ordering on an annual basis would be done by bid, however, delivery would still be 4 - 6 weeks.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the purchase of the street signs from Clackamas County Sign Shop for a cost of \$1,521.25.
