

RESOLUTION NO. 274

A RESOLUTION OF CERTIFICATION OF AN INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, PROPOSED BY CARDIAC RESUSCITATOR CORPORATION, AS BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, ORS 280.330 requires that the Washington County Board of Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") request the undertaking of eligible economic development projects within Washington County before they may be financed through the Economic Development Commission of the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Cardiac Resuscitator Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Company"), has requested that a project to be constructed in the City of Wilsonville, Washington County, Oregon, be granted project approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board may not give such project approval without the certification of the City Council of the City of Wilsonville that the project is in compliance with the City's Comprehensive Plan of Development:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE that the Company's project be certified to the Board as being in compliance with the Wilsonville Community Plan, the City's Comprehensive Plan of Development. This resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be forwarded to the Board of Commissioners of Washington County.
