SUBJECT: Approval to Purchase Portable Power Pressure Washer

The City Council in adoption of the 1982/83 Budget approved the allocation of \$2,800 for the purchase of a Portable Power Pressure Washer (P.P.P.W.) The P.P.P.W. is to be utilized at the Wastewater Treatment Plant (W.P.T.) for washdown of all Treatment Facilities which tend to accumulate grease and grime. The power washer can also be used for washing buildings, equipment and small parking areas.

According to Section 3.114 any item costing over \$2,000 is to be bid in a public bid process. Mr. Jerry LaPierre, however received purchasing quotes (attached) from 3 separate firms for 4 separate P.P.P.W. and the two lowest quotes were \$1,756.50 from Landa Inc. and \$1,885 from Helfrich Equipment Company. These quotes are good for 60 days, and are considerably lower than what was budgeted. Since the City can purchase the power washer for less than \$2,000 I therefore verify these quotes as being valid.

Recommendation

Approve the purchase of the Landa Portable Power Pressure Washer from Landa Inc. at a purchase price of \$1,756.50. Purchase price includes 4 nozzles, 50 ft. extra 2000 psi hose, chemical feed and 72" wand.

Fund shall be allocated from 02-50 71025 account.

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
