
A RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF BID FOR REMOVAL OF NOXIOUS

Proposals for bids were advertised in four separate newspapers for a period of two weeks for the removal of noxious vegetation. One bid was received from Landscape Enterprises, Inc.

David Schafer, President, submitted a bid as follows:

Per 1,000 sq. feet	\$ 2.50
Per average 6,000 sq ft lot	15.00
Per acre	27.50

Hauling excess brush, litter, etc. cutting down trees is an additional charge as listed:

Per manhour	11.50
Per truck hour	6.50

Landscape Enterprises met the bid specs as requested in the bid proposal.
