WHEREAS, endorsement of this City/County transportation package by all cities and the County will strengthen our shared

CONCERNING: RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CLACKAMAS COORDINATING TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE'S ACTION ON SIX (6) - YEAR PLAN PROJECTS

Representatives from cities in Clackamas County have been regularly meeting with Clackamas County transportation officials in an effort to coordinate the variety of traffic improvement projects to be submitted to the Oregon Department of Transportation for formal adoption of the six (6) - year plan. The goal of our meetings was to prepare and forward to the Oregon Transportation Commission a single recommendation of transportation projects supported by the endorsement of each jurisdiction.

The Transportation Committee's final recommendation could be summarized as follows:

First Priority:

Existing projects approved for Federal Aid Interstate (FAI) funding- including I-5/Wilsonville Interchanges.

Second Priority:

New projects requiring approval for FAI funding. In this list exists a third priority for a study on whether to improve the existing interchange at Charbonneau or construct a new one at Arndt Road.

Third Priority:

Existing projects approved for Federal Aid Primary (FAP) funding. Wilsonville has no projects proposed for this category.

Fourth Priority:

New projects requiring approval for FAP funding. Again, no projects pertaining to Wilsonville are proposed for this category.





In addition to the projects on the interstate and state highway system, Clackamas County has numerous projects that involve traffic safety on county roads. Among this list of projects, there are some which appear to be likely candidates for grant money. Although not in the city, one intersection currently being studied is that of Wilsonville Road and Edminston Road.

Recommendation:

Approve the recommendations of the Clackamas Transportation Coordinating Committee for submittal to ODOT for the six (6) - year plan update by adopting the appropriate resolution.
