

RESOLUTION NO. 700

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A TWO-YEAR TAX RATE SERIAL LEVY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, OREGON, AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 28, 1989.

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville Budget Committee has recommended to the City Council that they call for a Special Election for a two-year tax rate serial levy outside of the city's tax base; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the tax levy is to improve police services and street maintenance in the city; and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council is of the opinion that the citizens of the city should have the opportunity to decide on an increased level of services.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- A. A Special Election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Wilsonville a two-year Tax Rate Serial Levy outside the city's tax base. The tax rate proposed by the levy shall be \$.49 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. It is estimated that the levy will raise \$231,000 in year one and \$253,000 in year two. The levy will be in effect beginning in the 1989-90 fiscal year.
- B. The election hereby called shall be held on March 28, 1989.
- C. The election shall be conducted by mail ballot.
- D. The City Recorder shall cause to be delivered to the Elections Officers of Clackamas and Washington Counties the attached Notice of Measure

Election not later than February 16, 1989, which is the filing deadline for ballot measures for the March 28, 1989 Special Election. The Elections Officers shall conduct the election as required by law.


- E. The City Recorder shall give notice of the election by posting notice in three public places at least two weeks prior to the election.

NOTICE OF MEASURE ELECTION

Clackamas & Washington County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

CAPTION (10 Words): Two Year Operating Serial Levy

QUESTION (20 Words): Shall Wilsonville levy \$.49 per \$1,000 of assessed value for two years outside the tax base beginning in 1989-90.

*EXPLANATION: This levy is for the purpose of increasing police services and street maintenance. It is estimated that the levy will raise \$231,000 in year one and \$253,000 in year two. Police services will be increased by one eight-hour shift per day. The police services are estimated to cost \$60,000 in year one and \$63,000 in year two. The remaining funds received from the levy will be used for street repair.
