

RESOLUTION NO. 806

A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING CITIZEN PARTICIPATION IN CITY GOVERNMENT.


WHEREAS, in keeping with encouraging citizen participation in City government, it has been the general custom and practice of the City of Wilsonville to avoid having the same individual occupy positions on more than one board, commission or committee at any one time, save and except, where a position on a board, commission or committee has been structured to be occupied by a member of another board, commission or committee in order to facilitate communications and board liaisons for efficient government; and

WHEREAS, the current City Council of the City of Wilsonville desires to go on record as continuing to support such an appointment policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:



In order to support and encourage broad based citizen participation in local government, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville continues to support an appointment policy of avoiding having the same individual occupy positions on more than one board, commission or committee at any one time, save and except where a position on a board, commission or committee has been structured to be occupied by a member of another board, commission or committee to facilitate communication and board liaisons for efficient government.
