

RESOLUTION NO. 886

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY WITH RESPECT TO OVERPAYMENT OF SEWER USER FEES DUE TO WATER LEAKAGE.**

WHEREAS, non-residential sewer fees are based on water usage; and  
WHEREAS, from time to time water leaks occur that do not impact on non-residential sanitary sewer usage.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Where it can be clearly demonstrated that municipal water usage did not correspond to non-residential sanitary sewer usage due to water leakage, that any overpayment of sewer charges be credited according to the following schedule:


1. Customers will be credited for an amount equal to the difference between the actual sewage rate paid during the period of time that a leak went undetected and the average monthly billing during the period of time when there is no leakage.
2. In instances where a rate increase has occurred, the average monthly sewer charge would be adjusted upward to reflect the increased rate.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 16th day of December, 1991, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this date.
