

RESOLUTION NO. 905

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION OF AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SIGNS OTHER THAN FOR HEALTH, SAFETY AND TRAFFIC CONTROL ON CITY OWNED AND MAINTAINED PROPERTY INCLUDING RIGHTS-OF-WAY, DIRECTING STAFF ONLY TO PLACE SUCH AUTHORIZED SIGNS, PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES, AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR APRIL 20, 1992.

WHEREAS, the placement of signs, including for sale, for rent, garage sales and campaign signs, on the City's public property and rights-of-way, has caused the City to expend a great deal of time and energy policing same to prevent visual blight, to maintain sight clearance, to protect landscape and maintenance areas, and to resolve disputes over sign removal from City rights-of-way by abutting property owners supporting opposing candidates;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


- (1) Staff is directed to prepare an ordinance (a) prohibiting the placement of any signs not otherwise authorized by law for health and safety and as traffic control signs on City owned and maintained property including rights-of-way, (b) directing that only City staff shall be permitted to place such authorized signs, and (c) providing for enforcement and penalties; and
- (2) A public hearing for the proposed ordinance shall be scheduled for April 20, 1992.
