### **RESOLUTION NO. 1130**

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BID PROCESS; ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BID; AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; VERIFYING FUND AVAILABILITY; FOR THE PROJECT COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE REPAINTING OF THE ELLIGSEN ROAD RESERVOIR #1.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville adopted the 1994-95 budget which contains a Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program contains a project for the Repainting of the Elligsen Road Reservoir #1(Project #308); and

WHEREAS, the City duly advertised for competitive bids to construct the improvements in the Daily Journal of Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received prior to 2:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Savings Time, Thursday, July 21, 1994, at the Community Development Department, 8445 SW Elligsen Road, Wilsonville, Oregon 97070. Bids were then opened individually and separately read aloud after 2:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Savings Time on July 21, 1994. The Staff Report and Recommendation, Summary of Bids are marked Exhibit 'A', attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the bids and recommends that the contract be awarded to S & K Painting, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder for the Repainting of the Elligsen Road Reservoir #1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville desires to execute a Construction Contract Agreement in a timely manner; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The adopted 1994-95 budget of the City of Wilsonville contains a Capital Improvement Program and project known as the Repainting of the Elligsen Road Reservoir #1.

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2. The City Council acting as the local Contract Review Board finds and concludes all bids were duly advertised, received, publicly opened and approved as being completed for consideration for awarding according to the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 279, Public Bids and Contracting and Wilsonville Code 2.3.14, Contracts with the City, and the Attorney General's Model Rules which the City has adopted as its contracting rules.

3. Subject to the final review and approval of the City Engineer, staff is authorized to award the Repainting of the Elligsen Road Reservoir #1 to S & K Painting, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of <u>\$24,800.00</u>.
