

RESOLUTION FAILED - NOT ADOPTED

RESOLUTION NO. 1401

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A ROAD MAINTENANCE FEE FOR STREET MAINTENANCE AND RECONSTRUCTION TO BE VOTED UPON AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 16, 1997.

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee and City Council of the City of Wilsonville has determined that a permanent, stable and long-term funding source is needed for street maintenance and reconstruction in the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed a task force of residents and business representatives to study this issue and to make recommendations to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the task force has recommended a road maintenance fee as described in Resolution No. 1394 and Ordinance No. 484; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems this proposal to be of such city-wide significance that the voters of the city deserve the opportunity to approve or disapprove the fee in a special election;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. A special election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Wilsonville a Road Maintenance Fee, which shall be collected in addition to and not as a replacement for property taxes collected for the purpose of street maintenance and repair.
2. The Road Maintenance Fee shall be effective upon passage of the ballot measure.
3. The City Manager is instructed to prepare the ballot title to be filed with the Elections Officer, subject to review and approval of the City Attorney.
4. The election hereby called shall be held on September 16, 1997, and shall be a mail-in ballot.
5. The City Recorder or the City Recorder Pro-tem shall cause to be delivered to the Elections Officer of Clackamas and Washington Counties the Notice of Measure Election no later than July 17, 1997, which is the filing deadline for ballot measures for the September 16, 1997, special election. The Elections Officers shall conduct the election as required by law.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Wilsonville at a regular meeting thereof on the 10th day of July, 1997.
